## Instructions for Recorded <u>lightning talk video</u> for the 3rd National NetCOLOR meeting

Due to COVID-19, the 3rd National NetCOLOR meeting will be held virtually in a new formula. The meeting will take place every Wednesday of March 2021 between 1p.m. to 3p.m. EST.

For this occasion, we invite the research community, students and collaborators to come together for the month of NetCOLOR! We encourage students to use this event to present their projects, their results or even the innovative techniques used or developed.

You have to fill the <u>abstract submission form</u> if you want to present your project. It could be a 10 min oral presentation or a 2 min pre-recorded lightning talk video.

Please note that all lightning talk video have to be pre-recorded and must be submitted by the end of Monday February 15, 2021 to be included in the final program.

We ask that you email us a link to where we can download the file (either from Dropbox, Google Drive, OneDrive, or another file sharing platform). When naming your file, we ask that you use the file naming convention below. Use only periods, no dashes, commas or special characters and use the mpeg4 video format.

All 2-minutes pre-recorded lightning talk video must be submitted by end of Monday February 15, 2021.
